## Panzerkampfwagen T 34 - 747 (r)

The Soviet T-34 Tank as Beutepanzer and Panzerattrappe  
 in German Wehrmacht Service 1941-45

Beutepanzers, captured foreign tank designs in service with the Wehrmacht, played a much more influential role in German Panzer deployment and tactics than previously thought. While the bulk of Beute tanks were relegated to hinterland policing and anti-partisan duties, it was the hundreds of Soviet-built T-34s in German hands that were supporting Panthers in the medium tank and tank destroyer roles in combat everywhere along the frontlines in the East.

For the first time, this book sheds comprehensive light on the German Panzerkampfwagen T 34 - 747 (r), and underlines this detailed research with hundreds of photographs of the German T 34 in action. Unlike other publications so far released on the topic of Beutepanzers, this monograph focuses on the hardware rather than on the organisational paperwork of unit designations, readiness reports and unit deployment histories. It is consequently highly pictorial, showing tanks in service, their Soviet technology and production batches, as well as their German modifications and markings and it looks at the life of their crews. Furthermore, it outlines the T-34's development in the Soviet Union based on the most recent discoveries. As it is crucial to understanding the astonishing extent to which the T 34 was used in German service, and what an immense and important impact it had, the background of the German Beute principle is highlighted in an extended introduction.

Another major chapter in this book is devoted to T 34 Panzerattrappen dummy tanks that, to a hitherto unknown degree, were most influential in tactical anti-tank training and tactical doctrine for the Wehrmacht. The extent to which these T 34 dummies were used strongly underscores the thundering impact this Soviet medium tank had on the German side. The Panzerattrappen require a similarly extensive introduction in this book. Dating back to Kaiser and Reichswehr days, it allows readers to fully understand why 'wooden T 34s' played such a decisive role in German land warfare training.

## British Military Trucks in Wehrmacht Service

Captured Beutefahrzeuge of British manufacture were a significant addition to Germany's  
 military efforts in the later war years. Without these trucks, many stemming from the Battle of  
 Dunkirk, the German war machine would have been much less capable of waging Blitzkrieg  
 against the Soviet Union from 1941.

While Operation Dynamo, the evacuation from Dunkirk in May and June 1940, made  
 possible the escape of more than 300,000 French and British soldiers, they had to leave all  
 their heavy equipment behind. All in all, the BEF lost around 65,000 vehicles, many of which  
 returned to military service on the German side and doing their duty on the Eastern Front.  
 Other sources for the German Wehrmacht to lay its hands on British trucks to supplement its  
 own forces were Operation Demon in April 1941, the British evacuation from Greece, and the  
 campaign in North Africa from February 1941 to June 1943.

This publication offers for the very first time a comprehensive overview on the various British  
 Trucks in Wehrmacht Service, covering well-known models and makes such as the Bedford  
 and the Morris-Commercial GS trucks in the 8cwt to 3-ton range, the heavy Scammell  
 Pioneers and AEC Matadors, specialised vehicles such as cranes and field cars as well as  
 many rarer makes, rarities and oddities.

A special chapter also grants an overview on the Canadian-built vehicles of the British Army  
 that served with the Afrikakorps.

For all British military vehicle enthusiasts this book is a milestones.

## German Panzers and Allied Armour in Yugoslavia in World War Two



When the Yugoslavia theatre of operations in 1941-45 is mentioned, the first description that comes to mind is Bandenkampf (anti-Partisan warfare). And truly, more than any other theatre, fighting in the Balkans was among the most irregular and bloody of the whole of World War Two. This publication aims to close a vital gap in documentation of this campaign by providing the first comprehensive account of armoured vehicles and their respective units deployed there.

Combat in Yugoslavia also meant an exceptionally large number of combatants were involved. There was the German Wehrmacht, Waffen-SS, German Police, Italian Army, Soviet Army, British Army and, last but not least, various local ethnic groups fighting on one side or the other. All these were equipped with the most amazing and astonishing assembly of armoured vehicles of any theatre of operations in World War Two. Vehicles ranged from early German Panzers, German Beutepanzers captured in previous campaigns in France and Russia, uniquely outdated Italian tanks and tankettes, to the most modern Soviet and American equipment deployed later in the war. And as if that were not enough, this colourful gathering is furthermore enhanced by improvised armoured vehicles and armoured trains.



## British Military Trucks of the Cold War



Manufacturers, Types, Variants and Service of Trucks in the British Armed Forces 1945-79

The end of hostilities in 1945 left the British forces with a massive surplus of military vehicles placed throughout the many countries involved in the conflict. Much of this equipment after six years of war was in a very poor state of repair, and a lot was only fit for scrapping. The development and use of military trucks in the post-war period was therefore dominated by the feverish search for the ideal military vehicle.

Moves had been made between the War Office and British manufacturers to produce a family of standard types to avoid the logistical nightmare that had occurred during the war with so many different makes. This search for much more suitable tactical-truck designs in the early 1950s created a period that was brimming with new ideas.


The upcoming Cold War ushered in an incredible demand for a future, potentially nuclear clash between NATO and the Warsaw Pact on European soil. The fear of World War Three made possible one of the most creative design periods in military technology ever.

The introduction of the FV numbering system additionally aimed at standardising the British military vehicle. After the war it blossomed into the idea of idealised military truck designs. The result of this heyday of military vehicle development was amazing trucks taking shape on drawing boards.

This book aims at illustrating this amazing story for the very first time in one comprehensive publication.



## Artillerie-Zugmaschinen German Wheeled Artillery Tractors

Shortly before World War One, the German Army High Command began a massive project to test the suitability of agricultural tractors and ploughs possessing internal combustion engines for a potential role as future Artillerie-Zugmaschinen artillery tractors. The aim was to make even heavy artillery more mobile. Numerous German manufacturers responded to the call, and they supplied products for these trials. Based on evaluation findings, key data relating to a militarily usable artillery tractor began to be defined, which led to new and improved designs from 1916 onwards. This publication is the first monograph on the subject, and it presents in detail the history of these impressive motor vehicles with benzol engines in numerous fantastic photos. The vehicle types covered include the manufacturers Büsing, Dürkopp, Lanz, Podeus, Pöhl, Daimler, Benz, Standard-Motorpflug (Arator), Fürstlich Stolberg'sches Hüttenamt (Ilseburg), Kaelble, Horch, Sendling, Hanomag, Stock and Ehrhardt. An additional chapter covers the artillery load distribution trailer, the Lastenverteilergerät System Bräuer.

Beim Großmanöver REFORGER 78 kamen US-Einheiten bei den Herbstmanövern Saxon Drive und Certain Shield in der Bundesrepublik Deutschland zum Einsatz.

An der Korpsgefechtsübung Saxon Drive 78 des holländischen I (NL) Korps waren die Verbände der 1st Brigade, 4th (US) Infantry Division eingesetzt und operativ der 4. (NL) Division unterstellt. Die 3rd Brigade, 2nd (US) Armoured Division (Forward) kämpfte auf Seiten der Übungstruppe Blau.

Die Korpsgefechtsübung Certain Shield 78 war die größte Gefechtsübung der Landstreitkräfte der NATO diesen Jahres. Zu den wichtigsten Übungszügen gehörte das Vertrautmachen mit dem Gelände und der Lage für die aus den Vereinigten Staaten herangeführten REFORGER-Soldaten. Die Übungstruppe hatte eine Gesamtstärke von insgesamt 55.780 Soldaten und führte rund 6.370 Radfahrzeuge und 2.800 Kettenfahrzeuge sowie 562 Hubschrauber und 24 Flugzeuge ins Feld.

Mit dieser Publikation wird der Leser Augenzeuge einer lange vergangenen Ära. Die beeindruckenden Manöverfotos zeigen die Militärfahrzeuge der US Army und ihrer Alliierten im Zuge der Landkriegsführung im Herzen des Kalten Krieges.

*During REFORGER 78 forces from the USA were mainly deployed in the autumn manoeuvres Saxon Drive and Certain Shield in West Germany. During the corps training exercise Saxon Drive of the Dutch I (NL) Corps, units of the 1st Brigade, 4th (US) Infantry Division were operationally subordinated to the 4th (NL) Division. The 3rd Brigade, 2nd (US) Armored Division (Forward) fought on the side of Blue Force.*

*The corps training exercise Certain Shield 78 was the largest exercise of NATO land forces of that year. One of the most important objectives was to familiarise REFORGER troops, brought in from the USA, with the local conditions and the tactical situation. The exercise force had a total strength of 55,780 soldiers, and it fielded some 6,370 wheeled vehicles and 2,800 tracked vehicles as well as 562 helicopters and 24 aircraft.*

*Serving as an eyewitness to an era long gone this publication shows the US military vehicles and those of the allied nations during the two REFORGER 78 exercises in exiting photographs and allows the reader to visualize the land warfare tactics at the heart of the Cold War.*



Der Bandvagn 206 S im Dienste der Bundeswehr


*The Bandvagn 206 S in Bundeswehr Service*

Die Entwicklung des geschützten Bandvagn (Bv) 206 S als Nachfolger des Bv 206 D begann bereits in den späten 1980er Jahren. Anfang der 1990er Jahre begann sich auch die Bundeswehr für den Bv 206 S zu interessieren. Seit 1985 wurde zwar schon dessen Vorgänger, der Bv 206 D Husky sehr erfolgreich genutzt, jedoch suchte man nach einem geschützten Fahrzeug, um eine Lücke in der Fahrzeug- und Fähigkeitspalette der Luftlandekräfte zu schließen. Die Bundeswehr bestellte 2002 zunächst 31 Bv 206 S in der Variante Sanitätstrupp. Davon wurden vier im Rahmen eines einsatzbedingten Sofortbedarfs zum Beweglichen Arzttrupp (BAT) umgerüstet. Da die Truppe mit dem neuen Fahrzeug und dessen Leistung sehr zufrieden war, erfolgte 2004 die Bestellung weiterer 75 Fahrzeuge in der Variante Bv 206 S Transporttrupp, 2005 gefolgt von 81 Bv 206 S Gefechtsstandtrupp. Bis heute wurden 189 „Transport-Kraftfahrzeuge, leicht gepanzert, luftverladbar im taktischen Transportflugzeug C-160, Bv 206 S“ durch die Bundeswehr beschafft. Diese Publikation stellt alle Varianten erstmals in Bild und Text ausführlich vor.

*Development of the protected Bandvagn (Bv) 206 S, successor to the world-famous Bv 206 D, began in the late 1980s. At the beginning of the 1990s, the German Armed Forces began to take an interest in the vehicle. Since 1985, its predecessor, the Bv 206 D Husky was used very successfully, but the German Army was looking for a protected vehicle to close a gap in the range of vehicles and capabilities of its airborne forces. Consequently the Bundeswehr ordered 31 Bv 206 S Mobile Medical Team (MMT) Vehicles in 2002. Four of these were later converted to Mobile Evacuation Physician Team (MEPT) Vehicles. 75 of the Bv 206 S Armoured Personnel Carrier (APC) variant were purchased in 2004, followed by 81 Bv 206 S Command Post Vehicles in 2005. To date, 189 “transport vehicles, light armoured, air-transportable in C-160 tactical cargo aircraft, Bv 206 S” have been procured by the Bundeswehr. This publication shows the entire vehicle range for the first time in detail.*
