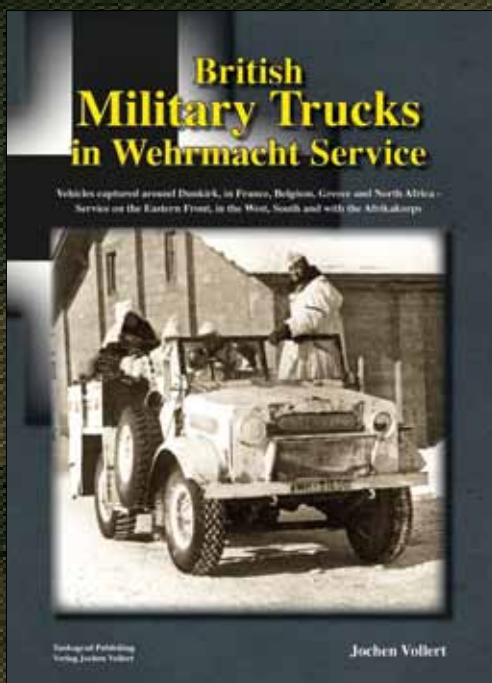
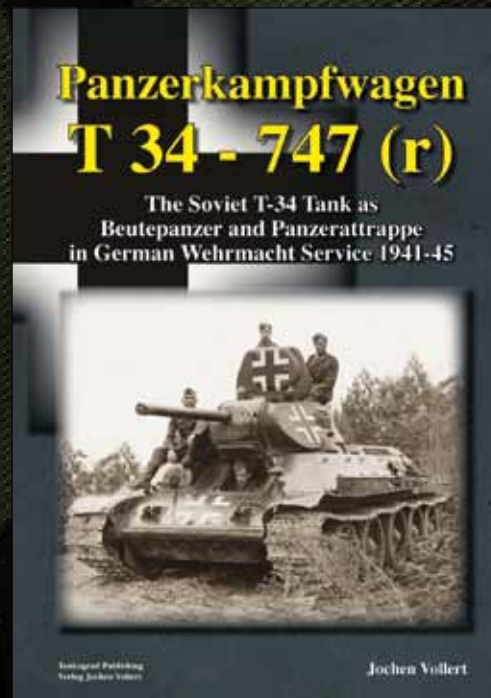
The Soviet T-34 Tank as Beutepanzer and Panzeratruppe
in German Wehrmacht Service 1941-45

Beutepanzer, captured foreign tank designs in service with the Wehrmacht, played a much more influential role in German Panzer deployment and tactics than previously thought. While the bulk of Beute tanks were relegated to hinterland policing and anti-partisan duties, it was the hundreds of Soviet-built T-34s in German hands that were supporting Panzers in the medium tank and tank destroyer roles in combat everywhere along the frontlines in the East.

For the first time, this book sheds comprehensive light on the German Panzerkampfwagen T 34 - 747 (r), and underlines this detailed research with hundreds of photographs of the German T 34 in action. Unlike other publications so far released on the topic of Beutepanzer, this monograph focuses on the hardware rather than on the organisational paperwork of unit designations, readiness reports and unit deployment histories. It is consequently highly pictorial, showing tanks in service, their Soviet technology and production batches, as well as their German modifications and markings and it looks at the life of their crews. Furthermore, it outlines the T-34's development in the Soviet Union based on the most recent discoveries. As it is crucial to understanding the astonishing extent to which the T-34 was used in German service, and what an immense and important impact it had, the background of the German Beute principle is highlighted in an extended introduction.

Another major chapter in this book is devoted to T 34 Panzeratruppen dummy tanks that, to a hitherto unknown degree, were most influential in tactical anti-tank training and tactical doctrine for the Wehrmacht. The extent to which these T 34 dummies were used strongly underscores the thundering impact this Soviet medium tank had on the German side. The Panzeratruppen require a similarly extensive introduction in this book. Dating back to Kaiser and Reichswehr days, it allows readers to fully understand why 'wooden T 34s' played such a decisive role in German land warfare training.

British Military Trucks in Wehrmacht Service

Captured Beutefahrzeuge of British manufacture were a significant addition to Germany's military efforts in the later war years. Without these trucks, many stemming from the Battle of Dunkirk, the German war machine would have been much less capable of waging Blitzkrieg against the Soviet Union from 1941.

While Operation Dynamo, the evacuation from Dunkirk in May and June 1940, made possible the escape of more than 300,000 French and British soldiers, they had to leave all their heavy equipment behind. All in all, the BEF lost around 65,000 vehicles, many of which returned to military service on the German side and doing their duty on the Eastern Front. Other sources for the German Wehrmacht to lay its hands on British trucks to supplement its own forces were Operation Demon in April 1941, the British evacuation from Greece, and the campaign in North Africa from February 1941 to June 1943.

This publication offers for the very first time a comprehensive overview on the various British Trucks in Wehrmacht Service, covering well-known models and makes such as the Bedford and the Morris-Commercial GS trucks in the 8cwt to 3-ton range, the heavy Scammell Pioneers and AEC Matadors, specialised vehicles such as cranes and field cars as well as many rarer makes, rarities and oddities.

A special chapter also grants an overview on the Canadian-built vehicles of the British Army that served with the Afrikakorps.

For all British military vehicle enthusiasts this book is a milestones.

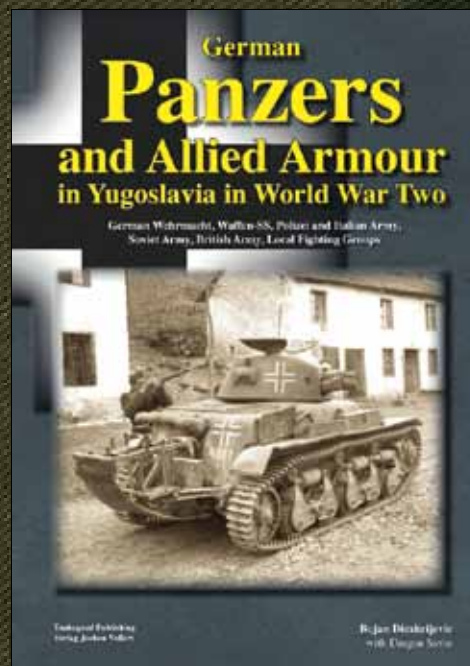

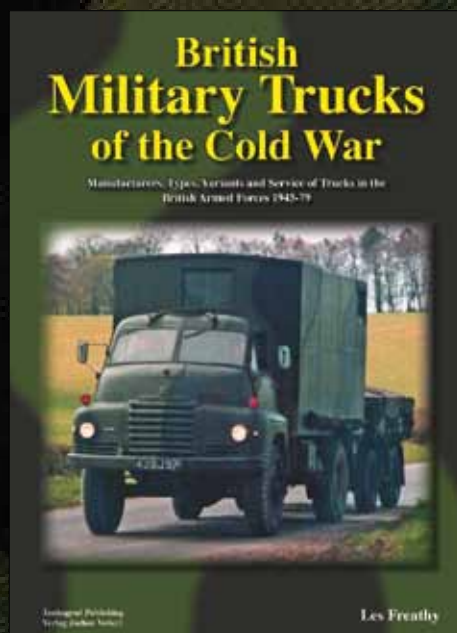

Vehicles ranged from early German Panzers, German Beutepanzers captured in previous campaigns in France and Russia, uniquely outdated Italian tanks and tankettes, to the most modern Soviet and American equipment deployed later in the war. And as if that were not enough, this colourful gathering is furthermore enhanced by improvised armoured vehicles and armoured trains. This book is a truly unique and outstanding compilation of armoured military vehicle rarities, curiosities and oddities!

Manufacturers, Types, Variants and Service of Trucks in the British Armed Forces 1945-79

The end of hostilities in 1945 left the British forces with a massive surplus of military vehicles placed throughout the many countries involved in the conflict. Much of this equipment after six years of war was in a very poor state of repair, and a lot was only fit for scrapping. The development and use of military trucks in the post-war period was therefore dominated by the feverish search for the ideal military vehicle.

Moves had been made between the War Office and British manufacturers to produce a family of standard types to avoid the logistical nightmare that had occurred during the war with so many different makes. This search for much more suitable tactical-truck designs in the early 1950s created a period that was brimming with new ideas.

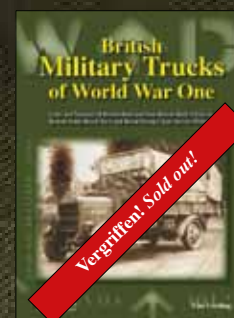
The upcoming Cold War ushered in an incredible demand for a future, potentially nuclear clash between NATO and the Warsaw Pact on European soil. The fear of World War Three made possible one of the most creative design periods in military technology ever.

The introduction of the FV numbering system additionally aimed at standardising the British military vehicle. After the war it blossomed into the idea of idealised military truck designs. The result of this heyday of military vehicle development was amazing trucks taking shape on drawing boards.

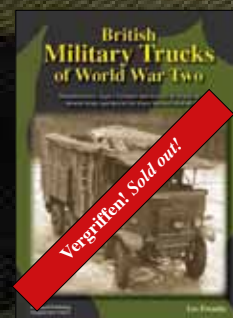

Artillerie-Zugmaschinen German Wheeled Artillery Tractors

Shortly before World War One, the German Army High Command began a massive project to test the suitability of agricultural tractors and ploughs possessing internal combustion engines for a potential role as future Artillerie-Zugmaschinen artillery tractors. The aim was to make even heavy artillery more mobile. Numerous German manufacturers responded to the call, and they supplied products for these trials. Based on evaluation findings, key data relating to a militarily usable artillery tractor began to be defined, which led to new and improved designs from 1916 onwards. This publication is the first monograph on the subject, and it presents in detail the history of these impressive motor vehicles with benzol engines in numerous fantastic photos. The vehicle types covered include the manufacturers Büssing, Dürkopp, Lanz, Pödeus, Pöhl, Daimler, Benz, Standard-Motorpflug (Arator), Fürstlich Stolberg'sches Hüttenamt (Ilseburg), Kaelble, Horch, Sendling, Hanomag, Stock and Ehrhardt. An additional chapter covers the artillery load distribution trailer, the Lastenverteilergerät System Bräuer.

Die Rad-Schützenpanzer-Familie Stryker IAV wurde eingeführt, um eine Fähigkeitslücke der U.S. Army bei einem schnell verlegbaren gepanzerten Gefechtsfahrzeug, das nur einen minimalen logistischen Aufwand benötigt aber über modernste Technologie verfügt, zu schließen. Dazu wurde eine neue Truppengattung aufgestellt die es vorher so nicht gab, die sogenannte "Medium Force". Mit ihr konnte die Fähigkeitslücke zwischen den leichten Infanterieverbänden und den schweren Panzerbrigaden geschlossen werden. Vorliegende Publikation zeigt erstmals die gesamte Stryker-Familie im Überblick, vom Basismodell ICV bis hin zu den neuesten Varianten.

The Stryker Interim Armored Vehicle (IAV) family was introduced to fill a US Army capability gap for a rapidly deployable armoured combat vehicle that required minimal logistical support and featured state-of-the-art technology. For this purpose, a new type of troop formation was created that did not exist before, namely the so-called "Medium Force". This was to close the capability gap between light infantry units and heavy tank brigades. For the first time this publication grants an overview over all Stryker variants, from its ICV basic model up to the most recent additions to the family.

September 2021 fand bei strahlendem Sonnenschein der feierliche Umgliederungsappell des Panzerpionierbataillons 130, der britischen 23 Amphibious Engineer Squadron sowie der 3./, 4./ und 5./ Kompanie des schweren Pionierbataillons 901 statt. Es entstand das Deutsch-Britische Pionierbrückenbataillon 130.

Die Hauptwaffensysteme des Verbandes sind die Faltschwimmbrücke (FSB 2), sie dient schweren geschützten Rad- und Kettenfahrzeugen sowie leichten taktischen Fahrzeugen zur Gewässerüberquerung, entweder als Schwimmbrücke oder als Mehrfach-Fähre; und die Schwimmschnellbrücke (SSB) Amphibie M3, sie entstand aus der konsequenten Weiterentwicklung des Konzepts des Brücken- und Übersetzfahrzeugs M2 Alligator. Der Verbund der kombinierten Eigenschaften eines Land- und Wasserfahrzeugs ist hierbei das wesentliche Leistungsmerkmal. Vorliegende Publikation beschreibt detailliert die Entstehungsgeschichte des PiBrBtl 130 und zeigt erstmalig alle Fahrzeuge des Verbandes in eindrucksvollen Manöverfotos.

On 30 September 2021, the reorganisation ceremony of the German Panzerpionierbataillon 130, the British 23 Amphibious Engineer Squadron and the 3rd, 4th and 5th Companies of schweres Pionierbataillon 901 took place in glorious sunshine. The German-British Amphibious Engineer Battalion 130 had been created. The main weapon systems of the DEU-GBR battalion are the Improved Ribbon Bridge / Faltschwimmbrücke (FSB 2), which is used by heavy armoured wheeled and tracked vehicles, as well as light tactical vehicles, for water obstacle crossings, either as a floating bridge or attached to a ferry; and the Amphibian M3 Schwimmschnellbrücke (SSB) high-speed floating bridge that is the result of further development of the M2 Alligator bridge and ferry vehicle. The combination of the twin capabilities of a land and water vehicle is the key performance feature here. Der Verteidigungsplan des I (BR) Corps gegen Ende des Kalten Krieges sah vor, die 1st und 4th (BR) Armoured Division am vorderen Rand der Verteidigung einzusetzen und die 3rd (BR) Armoured Division mit ihren drei Brigaden (4th, 6th und 33rd Armoured Brigade) als Reserve zurückzuhalten. Vor diesem Hintergrund fand das britische Manöver "Iron Hammer" (Eisenhammer), als letztes der NATO-Manöverserie "Autumn Forge" (Herbstschmiede) im Herbst 1988 in Deutschland statt. Die Gesamtstärke der teilnehmenden Truppen bei Iron Hammer 88 belief sich auf rund 25.300 Soldaten, einschließlich 1.600 Soldaten der Territorial Army aus Großbritannien, die mit 275 Kampfpanzern, 2.000 Kettenfahrzeugen, 4.000 Radfahrzeugen und 75 Hubschraubern im Feld standen. Zur Truppenerprobung wurden die Kampfpanzer FV4030/4 Challenger 1 Mk 2 einer Squadron der 17th/21st Lancers mit Kraftstoffzusatzfässern ausgestattet und zum ersten Mal wurde auf Divisionsebene auch der neue Schützenpanzer FV510 Warrior ISV eingesetzt.

The General Defence Plan of I (BR) Corps towards the end of the Cold War envisaged deploying the 1st and 4th (BR) Armoured Divisions on the forward edge of defence and keeping the 3rd (BR) Armoured Division with its three brigades (4th, 6th and 33rd Armoured Brigades) back as a reserve. Against this background, the British manoeuvre Iron Hammer, as the last of NATO's Autumn Forge manoeuvre series in Germany, took place in the autumn of 1988. The total number of troops participating in Iron Hammer 88 was approximately 25,300, including 1,600 Territorial Army soldiers from the United Kingdom, who were in the field with 275 main battle tanks, 2,000 tracked vehicles, 4,000 wheeled vehicles and 75 helicopters. For field testing, FV4030/4 Challenger 1 Mk 2 tanks of one squadron of the 17th/21st Lancers were each fitted with auxiliary fuel drums at the rear of the tank hull. For the first time at the divisional level, the new mechanised infantry fighting vehicle, the FV510 ISV Warrior, also deployed.

This publication shows the military vehicles of the participating units in dramatic exercise photographs partially in severe winter weather conditions.
